The Association of Community College Trustees (ACCT) has been selected to assist us with the Presidential search process. ACCT's assistance will include providing support with the development of the Presidential Profile, recruiting highly competitive candidates, and working extensively with the College and the Board of Trustees. ACCT has conducted over 750 community college searches and brings a wealth of knowledge and expertise to our process. ACCT's mission is to strengthen community college governance through education and advocacy. Stephen Head, Ph.D., and Julie Golder, J.D., ACCT Vice President of Search Services will serve as our ACCT Search Consultants and will assist the College throughout this important process.
